Regular Board of Aldermen Meeting
Monday, October 3, 2016
6:30 P.M.

Present for the Regular Board of Aldermen Meeting were Aldermen Eversmeyer, Detert, Sconce, Anderson, Curt, Walker and Mayor Cross. Also present were Wastewater Superintendent Peasel, Treasurer Flinn, City Attorney Granneman and City Clerk Schneider.

Mayor Cross called the Regular Board of Aldermen Meeting to order, announced a quorum, and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Cross relayed to the Board that the storm sewer repair on Buchanan Court resulted in a portion of sidewalk on Perkins Street being replaced. The Mayor obtained a bid in the amount of \$20,827.80 to replace the sidewalk that remained to match the new pour and extend the sidewalk to Boone Street on one side and Harris Street on the other. The Board's consensus was to obtain additional bids.

Jennifer Anders of Woodard & Curran updated the Board on the City's sewer improvement project. The State contacted her two weeks ago with a couple of questions on the SRF application but nothing alarming. Once approved, the next step was preparation of a facility plan. In order to prepare the facility plan, the routing for the interceptor will need to be determined for the environmental survey. Anders continued that the City needs to have easements before doing surveys to confirm routing of pipe and finalize the design.

Alderman Sconce made a motion, seconded by Alderman Eversmeyer to Go Into Closed Session in compliance with 610.021 of RSMo., for the purpose of discussing Legal and Real Estate. Vote: Sconce aye, Eversmeyer aye, Walker aye, Curt aye, Detert aye, Anderson aye.

Legal and Real Estate matters were discussed.

Alderman Sconce made a motion, seconded by Alderman Eversmeyer to Go Out of Closed Session. Vote: Sconce aye, Eversmeyer aye, Curt aye, Anderson aye, Walker aye, Detert aye.

Alderman Anderson made a motion, seconded by Alderman Sconce to adjourn the meeting. Vote: Anderson aye, Sconce aye, Curt aye, Detert aye, Eversmeyer aye, Walker aye. Meeting adjourned 8:14 p.m.
