## City of Troy, Missouri Regular Board of Aldermen Meeting Monday, February 6, 2017 6:30 P.M.

Present for the Regular Board of Aldermen Meeting were Aldermen Eversmeyer, Detert, Sconce, Anderson, Walker, Curt and Mayor Cross. Also present were Public Works Superintendent Cunningham, Parks Director Howell, Wastewater Superintendent Peasel, City Attorney Granneman, Treasurer Flinn and City Clerk Schneider.

Mayor Cross called the Regular Board of Aldermen Meeting to order, announced a quorum, and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Parks Director Howell relayed the job shadow request by Thomas Frye, a Junior at Troy Buchanan High School. The program is ten hours of job shadowing by the end of the school year and would encompass duties of the pool, scheduling, hiring, etc. but not include operating vehicles or power equipment. Alderman Sconce made a motion, seconded by Alderman Eversmeyer to Approve Job Shadowing Request by Thomas Frye with Parks Director Howell. Wastewater Operator Peasel handed out pictures of failing membrane material at the MBR Sewer Plant and an estimate of replacement costs in the amount of \$20,100.00. The failing membranes are eleven years old with a life expectancy of seven years. Kubota has quoted ¼ of membranes needed to operate the plant for two to three more years in the amount of \$185,200.00. Peasel explained steps taken to delay the purchase of membranes and higher costs for sludge thickening/hauling if not purchased. He continued to explain that the new membranes will still be utilized into the sewer improvement project slated for operation in the next several years. Alderman Curt made a motion, seconded by Alderman Anderson to Approve Purchase of Membrane Cartridge as quoted by Kubota Membrane USA Corporation of \$185,200.00.
