Public Hearing/Special Board of Aldermen Meeting
Monday, August 29, 2016
6:30 P.M.

Present for the Regular Board of Aldermen Meeting were Aldermen Eversmeyer, Detert, Sconce, Anderson, Walker and Mayor Cross. Alderman Curt was absent. Also present were City Attorney Granneman and City Clerk Schneider.

Mayor Cross opened the Public Hearing for citizen input on the property tax rate proposed to be set by the City of Troy, a political subdivision.

There was no citizen input.

Immediately following the Public Hearing, Special Board of Aldermen Meeting:

Mayor Cross called the Special Board of Aldermen Meeting to order, announced a quorum, and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Pat Todd, 244 Excalibur, Troy, Missouri inquired about the choice to engineer plans for a roundabout at Cherry and Wood Street on the Cherry Street Improvement Project. Mayor Cross replied that MoDOT engineers have utilized roundabouts across Missouri to improve traffic flow, efficiency and safety. Ms. Todd did not agree that roundabouts were safe and viewed an accident on the MoDOT roundabouts at South Lincoln and Hwy 61. Alderman Eversmeyer opined the interchange was much safer than when it was a crossover and no serious, life-threatening injuries had occurred since they were put in. Ms. Todd asked if the City's personal property tax and real estate tax will stay the same as last year. Mayor Cross explained that after the City's voluntary reduction of \$.15 cents, the property tax rate rose fractionally from \$0.1900 cents to \$0.1922 cents per \$100 assessed valuation.

Alderman Anderson made a motion, seconded by Alderman Detert to Approve and Set Property Tax Rate 2016 (effective 2017) to \$0.1922 Per \$100 Assessed Valuation (which Includes a Voluntary Reduction By the City of \$.15 cents). Vote: Anderson aye, Detert aye, Eversmeyer aye, Sconce aye, Walker aye.

Alderman Sconce made a motion, seconded by Alderman Walker to Approve and Authorize Mayor to Sign 2016-2017 Health, Dental, Vision, and Life Insurance Renewals as Recommended by City of Troy Insurance Committee. Vote: Sconce aye, Walker aye, Anderson aye, Eversmeyer aye, Detert aye.

Alderman Sconce made a motion, seconded by Alderman Eversmeyer to Approve and Authorize Mayor to Sign Sworn Statement in Proof of Loss, Claim #PR2016006109

(Well 14 Lightning Strike on July 19, 2016) in the amount of \$17,647.00. Vote: Sconce aye, Eversmeyer aye, Detert aye, Walker aye Anderson aye.

Alderman Eversmeyer made a motion, seconded by Alderman Sconce to Adjourn the Meeting. Vote: Eversmeyer aye, Sconce aye, Detert aye, Anderson aye, Walker aye. Meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
