

Job Description
Seasonal Water Maintenance Worker I

City of Troy, Missouri
Water Department

General Purpose of Position

Maintains and repairs City grounds and facilities – including, but not limited to water facilities, buildings and hydrants - as needed. This is a temporary seasonal position from approximately April 1st to November 1st of each year not to exceed a total of 1500 hours per year.

Major Duties and Responsibilities

Assists with departmental operations

- Performs maintenance of grounds, including landscaping, turf management, and arboricultural activities
- Performs maintenance of equipment and buildings including cleaning, painting, and minor plumbing and carpentry projects
- Performs seasonal activities, including hanging and removing decorations, flags, etc.
- Performs mowing including trimming with string trimmer, various mowing equipment, etc.

Assists other departmental staff as needed, including water and sewer emergencies, performs other duties as directed.

The person in this position must have a valid Missouri Chauffeurs Driver's license.

- Ability to safely and efficiently operate various types of mowing equipment from riding mowers, push mowers, to string trimmers
- Basic equipment maintenance and repair

- Use common sense
- Pay attention to detail
- Work as a team member with other employees
- Work autonomously when necessary
- Work effectively with a wide range of people
- Follow procedures to maintain vehicle and equipment
- Meet specified deadlines
- Maintain professional composure in heated situations
- Follow departmental and City policies and procedures
- Ability to lift 50 lbs on a regular basis, and occasionally lift 80 to 100 lbs
