

The city hall business hours will be changing to 8am – 4:30pm Mon. – Fri. The new hours are designed to coincide with the hours of other government offices in Lincoln County.

Sales tax revenues for October we down 1.28% vs. last October but for the year we are still ahead 3% YTD. Collection of the new Capital Improvement Tax began on October 1, 2011 and the city has completed the asphalt portion of the 2011 street project. We will be letting the bids for the concrete streets in the next few weeks but we will have to see how the weather holds up as to how much can be done before winter.

Croghan and Croghan Certified Public Accountants will be conducting the city's annual audit November 3rd and 4th.
