

INVITATION FOR BID – CITY OF TROY **VILLA DRIVE SIDEWALK** **IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT NO. 190913**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Troy will receive sealed proposals at City Hall, 800 Cap au Gris Street, Troy, Missouri until **10:00 am local time, October 22, 2020 for the Villa Drive Improvements Project**. All bids will be publicly opened and read shortly thereafter.

The Scope of the Work shall include: Sidewalk, Signal Modifications and Street Lighting improvements along Villa Drive between Route 47 and Commerce Street, a distance of about 1,375 linear feet, more or less.

The bid proposal shall be made on a form of proposal, provided in the specifications and delivered in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside **Bid No. 190913** to the City Clerk's Office on or before the time specified above. No facsimiles will be accepted. The proposal shall be accompanied by a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check of a bank or trust company in Lincoln County, St. Charles County, St. Louis County, or in the City of St. Louis for an amount not less than five (5%) percent of the bid amount. The amount of the check shall be forfeited to the City if the bidder neglects or refuses to enter into a contract or to furnish bond after its proposal has been accepted.

A hard copy of the plans and specifications are now on file for viewing at the City of Troy, Missouri. Electronic plans and specifications in pdf format are available for download at no charge by calling HR Green, Inc. at (636) 812-4200. A link to download plans and specifications will then be emailed to interested contractors.

The City of Troy will award the project to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. The City reserves the right to require the successful bidder to file proof of its ability to properly finance and execute the project together with its record of successful completion of similar projects. Pursuant to MoDOT approval, the City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, offers, or proposals submitted, or to advertise for new bids. The City reserves the right to defer the acceptance of any proposal and the execution of a contract for a period not exceeding sixty (60) days after the date of opening of the bids. The successful bidder to whom the contract has been awarded shall sign the contract and performance bond and other required certificates in triplicate and return the signed documents within seven (7) days after the date of their receipt.

The successful bidder shall furnish a performance bond and payment bond for one hundred (100%) percent of the contract amount and shall file certificates with the City that it has obtained and will continue to carry workmen's compensation insurance, public and private liability, and property damage insurance, and builder's risk insurance in an adequate amount for the duration of the contract.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City reserves the right to remove a portion of the work if insufficient funds are available to cover the entire amount of the bid.

The City of Troy hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award. The City of Troy, Missouri, fully complies with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, Current Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project must provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

The DBE Goal for this project is 10%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
